Sacramento District Attorney Jan Scully Backs Runner for BOE
Adds to growing list of law enforcement support

SACRAMENTO—Senator and Taxpayer Advocate George Runner has announced the endorsement of Sacramento District Attorney Jan Scully in his race for Board of Equalization. Scully's name is the latest in a growing list of law enforcement officials backing Runner's campaign from around the state.
