Senate Colleagues Back Runner for BOE

Senators Aanestad, Dutton and Strickland join growing list of supporters

SACRAMENTO—Today, Senator and Taxpayer Advocate George Runner announced the endorsement of Republican State Senators Sam Aanestad, Bob Dutton and Tony Strickland in his campaign for Board of Equalization. These endorsements mark the latest in a growing list of supporters from every corner of the district.
